Laurent Perrier Brut, France £32.00

Chardonnay is the dominant grape variety and its proportion is unusually high for a non-vintage champagne blend, being double the average. Pale and golden in colour with a fresh and delicate nose and a hint of almonds. Good bubbles and rich fruit flavours with a delightful lemon finish.

Laurent Perrier Rose, France £55.00

The definitive Rose Champagne. Pinot Noir at its brilliant best! Soft strawberry aromas entice you to try, which allows you to discover its gentle mousse with the ripest up-front fruit on the palate and its long lingering sensational finish! This stunning Champagne is worth every penny.

Light silvery colour, fine elegant aromatic nose, a full sensual mouth with citrus pineapple flavour.

2. Chardonnay Valonga, Valle del Cinca	£3.00	£3.90	£11.50
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Nocturnal harvest. Possessing a vibrant silvery gold colour with aromas of apple and citrus fruits. This dry, tangy, ultra tasty wine won the Silver medal at the Worlds Best Chardonnay Competition in 2005. Champion!

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Light silver colour, powerful nose, greengage and tropical fruit aromas, well integrated, fresh and ample floral citrus finish.

Valle del Cinca

A frontier province of Northern Spain originally belonging to Aragon. Belongs to mountain system of the Pyrenees retaining the highest altitudes.

Carinena

Carinena is the oldest regio on the province of Zaragoza, Aragon. The wine grape Carignan gets its name from there. The most typical traditional Spanish taste.

Rias Baixas
